

Indirect Cost Policy

Indirect Costs in Project Budgets

An organization may include indirect costs in their project budgets if they meet the following conditions.

- 1. The organization has a federally-approved indirect rate; and
- 2. the organization submits documentation* of their federally-approved rate with their full proposal application.

Indirect costs as Matching Contributions

If an organization does not include indirect costs in their request from the Foundation, the organization and their project partners may include their full federally-approved indirect rate as matching contributions for a Foundation award.

Effective date: The matching funds policy applies to all GM-STS Foundation, Inc projects funded after October 5, 2022.
