APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

The minutes of the Gypsy Moth Slow the Spread (STS) Foundation Board of Directors' Conference Call on September 5, 2007 were approved and ratified by unanimous vote and shall be filed in the Minute Book.

STATUS UPDATES OF GRANT AGREEMENTS

Ed Holloman discussed the current Grant Reporting Schedule and pending grant award balances and expenditures.





2007 APHIS Regulatory Grant

Ed indicated as of 10/02/07 there is a balance of \$40,394.35 in undisbursed Foundation funds. North Carolina has a pending disbursement. It is anticipated that all state funding will be drawn down to zero before the final closeout of the grant which ended on 09/30/07. No states anticipate any deobligations at this time.

Ed indicated that all states are up-to-date on all reporting requirements at this time.

Gene Cross noted that it is important that States spend down all funds by the end of the grant period so that the Foundation does not have to return unspent funding to APHIS in light of our request for future additional APHIS funding.

Gene also indicated that the 2008 grant package was submitted to APHIS and Letters of Award would be issued as soon as the Foundation receives their final approval.

Scott Frank questioned the final grant report due dates of 11/01/07. Ed Holloman noted that some flexibility exists with this date since the final submission date by the Foundation to APHIS is 12/31/07; however, it is appreciated if the states can submit final reports as soon as possible if not by 11/01/07 to allow ample time to finalize the Foundation's final reports to APHIS.

2006 Forest Service Trapping & Treatment Grant

Ed indicated that all finds have been encumbered and the grant has been closed out with a zero balance. Ed indicated that all states are up-to-date on all reporting requirements. The 2006 Trapping and Treatment Grant will be deleted from future grant spreadsheets.

2007 Forest Service Trapping & Treatment Grant

Ed indicated as of 10/02/07 there is a balance of \$1,806,284.95 in grant funds available to the states out of the total grant award of \$3,596,451.00 for funding to the states. The overall Foundation budget shows a balance of \$2,902,873.94 out of the original grant award of \$6,104,202.00. Donna requested that States look at their past and projected expenditures to see if they will have any projected deobligations.

Ed indicated that all states are up-to-date on all reporting requirements at this time.

Gene requested comments from the States on the new spreadsheet format and still received only positive feedback.

ECONOMIC ASSESSMENT REVIEW

Dr. Erin Sills, Department of Forestry and Environmental Resources, NC State University, gave a status overview of her work on the *Assessment of the Economic Feasibility of the Gypsy Moth Slow the Spread Project*. An outline was distributed reporting the projects objectives, personnel, timeline, tacks, and products (See attached outline). The bottom line: Are Benefits greater than the Costs? Depends upon what assumptions are made regarding high/medium/low activity and benefit estimates. JoAnn Cruse, USDA-APHIS, indicated that additional data is being compiled by APHIS on various state administrative costs and industry costs.

Dr. Sills will present a preliminary analysis at the Annual GM Review in October 2007 and an updated analysis at the GM Research Forum in January 2008.

MISCELLANEOUS

STS Annual Meeting Date

Tentative dates for the 2008 STS Annual Board Meeting were set for February 12-13 or February 20-21, 2008, in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Renewal of SEAS Contract

Gene Cross updated the Board on a draft Personal Services Contract to renew the services of Ed Holloman as the Administrative Officer for the STS Foundation on an annual basis at a rate of \$1,690 per month.

MOTION:

Melody Walker made a motion with a second by Scott Frank to approve the proposed Personal Services Contract and have Gene move forward to obtain signatures. The motion passed unanimously.

State/Private Forestry Redesign

Gene Cross updated the Board on his attendance at a meeting of the National Association of State Foresters for the National Plant Board. There was much discussion on the State/Private Forestry Redesign. Not all State Foresters support this initiative at the 15% level this year and feel it to ambitious. Several representatives of the National Plant Board, including Gene Cross, will meet with USDA Forest Service personnel to discuss this issue further. It was noted that USDA-Forest Service needs to be reminded that State Department of Agriculture regulatory agencies are an integral partner with the State Foresters in addressing forest pest issues.

STS Regulatory Program

JoAnn Cruse gave an update on the STS Regulatory Program. There is an STS Regulatory Meeting scheduled for November 1st following the National Gypsy Moth Review. Board President Geir Friisoe plans to address the group on the goals and objectives of the Regulatory Committee. Issues to be discussed include: annual work plan review, differing state program

activities, and various state administrative/field obligations. What are the opportunities for annual flexibility in individual state funding for GM regulatory activities?

Letter of Thanks for Service to STS

Frank Fulgham noted that a Letter of Appreciation was warranted to John Walkowiak, Iowa, for his service to the Board. John resigned from the STS Board and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources on September 28, 2007, to accept a position with the Washington Department of Revenue in Olympia running their Forest Tax Program. The Board concurred that John should be acknowledged for his service to STS.
