STATUS UPDATES OF GRANT AGREEMENTS

2015 APHIS Regulatory Grant

The grant balance was \$18,386.27 as of July 26, 2016. Virginia and Minnesota plan to draw their remaining balances down. The Final Performance Report and the Financial Status Report are due on August 1. This grant ended on May 23, 2016.

2016 APHIS Regulatory Grant

This grant has been awarded and the award amount is/was \$110,000. No disbursals have been made to date. Please note that the financial status reports are due quarterly, but the performance reports are due semi-annually. Donna and Ed will get clarification on the timelines for the performance reports.

2015 Forest Service Trapping and Treatment Grant

The Final FSR and the 424 with final expenses or deobligated funds are due to Ed by July 15. The financial status for each sub-recipient is listed below:

- Illinois deobligation is in at \$20, 604 and is over by \$10.00
- Indiana deobligation is in at \$26,255 and is over by \$.02
- Iowa Michigan Ohio Washington University balance is at zero
- Minnesota plans to draw down the remaining balance \$20,795.19
- Wisconsin plans to draw down the remaining balance of \$91,916.94
- Kentucky may deobligate or may submit a revised FSR for \$1140.09
- North Carolina deobligation of \$18,809.61 is on the way
- Virginia deobligation is in at \$13,327.24
- West Virginia plans to deobligate \$25,000 to \$27,000

2016 Forest Service Trapping and Treatment Grant

This grant sum for this period is a total of \$4,822,600.00 The balance in sub grant awards was \$2,849,593.74 as of July 27, 2016. There is about \$30,000 that is not planned for anything specific expenditure at this time.

Next reports are not due until February 2017.

New Guidelines for Procurements Associated with Uniform Grant Guidance (Larry & Phil)

Based on new guidelines for procurements, the Foundation must release a RFP every three to five years to promote fair and open competition.

The Foundation needs to be in full compliance by September 30. This means all procurements must comply by the end of September 2016. Foundation contracts with accountants and SEAS have been in effect for more than 5 years, therefore both must compete. Draft RFP for accountants (to be distributed before the call)

Key contacts will be Ed (audits only), Phil Wilson and Donna.

Phil Wilson will contact several firms with likely capabilities and form a committee to review the applications. The review committee will consist of Phil Marshall, Tivon and Melody. The plan is to get out the RFP out by mid-August and review applications by the end of August. The call normally scheduled for the first Wednesday in September is to be postponed until Friday, September 16 to allow time for review of proposals and recommendations for award.

*Note – Ed Holloman left the conference call prior to the discussion of financial services.

There was considerable discussion concerning the contents of RFPs.
