2019-20 APHIS Regulatory Grant

Total funds in this award was \$110,000. There has been a total of \$73,645.25 in disbursements to five states (IL, MN, VA, WV, WI). There is one pending disbursement of \$4,401.02 for IL and \$4,597.90 for VA. IL has deobligated \$5,435.49 and due to award deadlines, these funds were unable to be utilized by the other partnering STS states, so this will be deobligated on the STS award to USDA-APHIS. With this deobligation the balance is at \$20,820.34, however MN will be submitting their final request soon in the amount of \$20,820.34 bringing this balance to zero. States are encouraged to communicate any challenges in spending their funds as early as possible to move funds to other states within STS.

2019 Forest Service Trapping and Treatment Grant

Total funds in the grant is \$5,718,682.00. There are two pending subgrant payments, WV \$107,726.01 and University of VA \$9,022.82 for a total of \$116,748.83. There are two deobligation of funds submitted, NC \$11,782.67 and VA \$11,710.31 for a total of \$23,492.98. Balance in subgrants is \$61,276.49. Total spent on the full award is \$5,560,340.35. Balance is \$158,341.65. Waiting for deobligations from KY (\$30.11), WV (\$2,789.97) and SUNY (\$20.68). John Walter, University of VA is asking for an extension to complete their work. States are encouraged to close out their subgrants as soon as possible, particularly due to the delays related to Covid-19.

2020 Forest Service Trapping and Treatment Grant

Total funds in the grant is \$5,253,602.00. Balance in subgrants is \$2,648,242,81. There are no pending requests from states. Total spent on the full award is \$1,271,076.34. Balance is \$3,982,525.66.

Foundation Expenses related to invoices for trappers are experiencing some slight delays, but overall, these are being paid out rather quickly. Mating disruption contract stayed on budget this year we were within 1% of the actual treatment acres estimated. Historically contingency funds are used for any overages in the mating disruption contract. This year that overage was only \$2,080. Final invoice has been received and processed to Al's Aerial Spraying.

PROGRAM UPDATES

2020 STS Program Work/Budget Plans

The budget summary was updated to add the extra acres for the mating disruption acres to Al's Aerial Spraying of \$2,080 and decrease in some of the expenses for Btk work that did not come to fruition in NC and VA. This allowed for an increase in the budget line item for the 2020 Racemic purchase increasing it to \$917,230. In addition, historically contingency funds are added to this racemic purchase. The current contingency funds are at \$199,202. The budget is in a good place, but Tom Coleman does not feel the Board will need all these funds in this line item, due to racemic storage limitation and historical use or racemic on our annual mating disruption projects.

Coleman feels that \$850,000 would be adequate for the 2020 racemic purchase, which results in about 2,325 kg. This year we utilized just around 2,000 kg. The increased purchase will allow for some racemic carry over and allow a cushion if there is a need to reduce racemic purchase in 2021. Coleman is targeting a 14-drum purchase for fall of 2020. APHIS can store 17 drums, and typically each year the programs utilizes 12 drums, so this will give the program 2 extra drums as compared to 2019 use. The Foundation is in a better position than in the past to be able to fill storage without using it all in the same year. The racemic request is targeted to go out in September.

The Board supported Coleman's budget proposal for the 2020 racemic purchase and contingency fund carry over.

STS Activities from June-July

2020 Treatment Update:

- Completed mating disruption treatments on time despite some delays early in the season.
- No incidents or accidents on the project were reported.
- Two Foundation funded Btk blocks were cut due to delays related to contracting and delays related to Covid-19. One Btk block within the STS action area in VA and one Btk eradication block in NC.
- Covid-19 also caused some delays in moth rearing at OTIS laboratories that are utilized on the STS research project. Despite delays the project was able to move forward.
- Racemic purchase as delayed by two months, arriving in early June, however, did not cause impacts to the 2020 mating disruption season.
