Monthly requests are preferred but quarterly requests are required. STS 2022 Budget; Tom Coleman (FS) Remaining funds to be carried over Racemic is a huge chuck of the spending and the amount variable. STS 2023 Budget; Tom Coleman (FS) Under continuing resolution until December and it is uncertain with the mid-term elections. Early forecast is that the budget currently is holding flat. Foundation has around \$1 million that can be used for early awards. This would help the STS Foundation get payments out early for the program needs such as trapping contracts. Setting this up will probably be more up-front work but should make it easier in the long run for administering reimbursement requests. Tom Coleman (FS) is going to ask more questions to be sure what the STS Board can and can't do. Bob Rabaglia is considering retirement from Forest Service and has been a champion of the Slow the Spread work.
