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- One advance modification for all 2023 funds
- Pros and Cons offered
  - Reimbursement Modification
    - Pros: Easy to Manage
    - Cons :Payments of invoices from the FS may vary (2-6 weeks)
  - Advance Modification
    - Pros: Payments should be quicker for trappers and all funds supported by the modification
    - Cons: Must spend all funds down before requesting additional funds.
- Discussion:
  - Phil Marshall (IN): If did advance modification for all 2023 funds, would it affect us getting additional funds?
    - No, a modification of the grant would be needed.
  - Kimberly Thielen Cremers (MN) preference for option 1. Others are leaning this way as well.
  - Due to the delays in receiving payment from the FS it is suggested that a letter to the Forest Service (Southern Region Forester) be written regarding our concern.
    - Tom Coleman (FS), Georgia Brock (STS Foundation), and Kimberly Thielen Cremers (MN) will draft a letter to present at the February Board Meeting.
- ATGC Biotech Pvt. Ltd. contacted Tom Coleman (FS) that they may be delayed getting racemic disparlure shipment by April 2023 due to ATGC getting registration completed with EPA.
  - Requested to extend the delivery to later in 2023 (August 1, 2023)?
  - The Board is working with ATCG through Tom Coleman (FS) to provide information and letters of support to the EPA in the hope of expediting the approval for delivery.
  - Motion by Larry Nichols (VA) to allow for the delay of delivery of the disparlure until August 1, 2023.

  - Board will look to discuss any penalties should it go past August 1, 2023, at the February meeting.
