	 Racemic has been produced and delivery should be coming on or before August 2023. Looking at getting RFP for racemic contracts sooner than later to account for the April 10, 2024, grant term limit. Storage is the issue. Asking ISCA to update FAQ sheet for next treatment season. NC is looking for a statement on the product in water. Treatments: Started in NC last weekend. Delays have been longer than normal (windy, rainy, foggy, etc.) Treatments at Outer Banks occurred on Sunday. Currently in Virginia. Building in the buffer in the treatment plan has the schedule still on time at this point.
7. APHIS update	Kathryn Bronsky (APHIS) Survey supplies procurement program 2 vendors are in the testing looking at the delta trap glue, trap color, and how it withstands the season. If any states are interested in testing that is available. Just message Kathryn Bronsky the number you are interested in. May see about using some of Ksenia's test plots. This is the first testing in the field and will be looked at from the diagnostics perspective as well.

If we do change, the ripple effect of all the organizations that would need to be updated will be very challenging – especially the government organizations (i.e., SAM). May consider not changing the articles of incorporation and just be a "DBA: STS Foundation Board". Joy Goforth (NC) will look into using a DBA option. Phil Marshall (IN) reminded the STS Foundation Board about the spray meeting coming up August 8, 2023. Emails have gone out. Contact Phil Marshall for more information.
